What is your position within your organisation: Substantive Consultant Diabetes and General Internal Medicine

## What is your current role(s) and relevant experience of/interests in diabetes:

I am a substantive consultant in Diabetes at University Hospitals Of Leicester, having taken up the post in May 2023. Most of my clinical time is dedicated to diabetes, with specific clinics for foot and antenatal, and an interest in T1DM and technology.

I have a keen interest in quality improvement in the field of diabetes. In addition to being local M&M lead, I have presented an audit on T1DM pathway at DUK and I am currently leading an audit to improve glucokinase screening in pregnancy.

I have an active role in supporting undergraduate and post-graduate education. Over the last 18months I have been co-ordinating the departmental weekly teaching, liaising with other specialities and industry experts to support continuing professional development of the diabetes team.

## What is your involvement in ABCD activities to date:

Since becoming a member as a first year registrar I have benefitted from attending the numerous and diverse ABCD events, including the ABCD consultant development program, ABCD SpR meeting, DTN meeting and ABCD annual meetings. Furthermore, I have previously published in BJD and have further articles currently under consideration.
