If a paper is accepted, the author identified as the corresponding author will receive an e-mail requesting they complete a copyright license agreement (Consent-To-Publish) on behalf of all authors of the paper. By signing the agreement, authors agree to publish under the terms of the journal's standard copyright agreement, which recognises the common interest that both journal and author(s) have in the protection of copyright.

All requests to reproduce or make available anything in the journal—in whole or in part, in electronic or in any other form, including translation—should be made through the BJD.
