2016 - 17 Collection

What you need to know

The provisional dates for the 2016 – 17 collection of the NDA have been announced. Organisations will have six weeks to submit their audit data to the NDA during the following dates.

Monday 12 June 2017	Friday 21 July 2017

Who should take part?

Specialist services that provide outpatient diabetes care and insulin pump clinics. It is important that teams work together to submit one complete response for all their diabetes outpatients. Reports are based on the level they are submitted at, e.g. hospital or trust, please consider this when completing the template.

What's changed

Open Exeter will no longer be accepting NDA submissions. All submissions will be accepted through the NDA's secure web site Data Landing. If you don't already have an account for Data Landing you can register. Guidance on how to create an account can be found here

Legal basis in which the NDA collects the data has changed. As of April 2017 we are being directed by NHS England to collect the audit data. The new legal basis means that health care providers, both in primary and secondary care, are required to participate in the audit. Further information can be found in our NDA fact sheet.

Multiple Readings for BMI, HBA1c, Blood pressure, and Cholesterol are now to be collected by the NDA for each patient. The CSV has been modified to enable specialist services to enter this data.
