



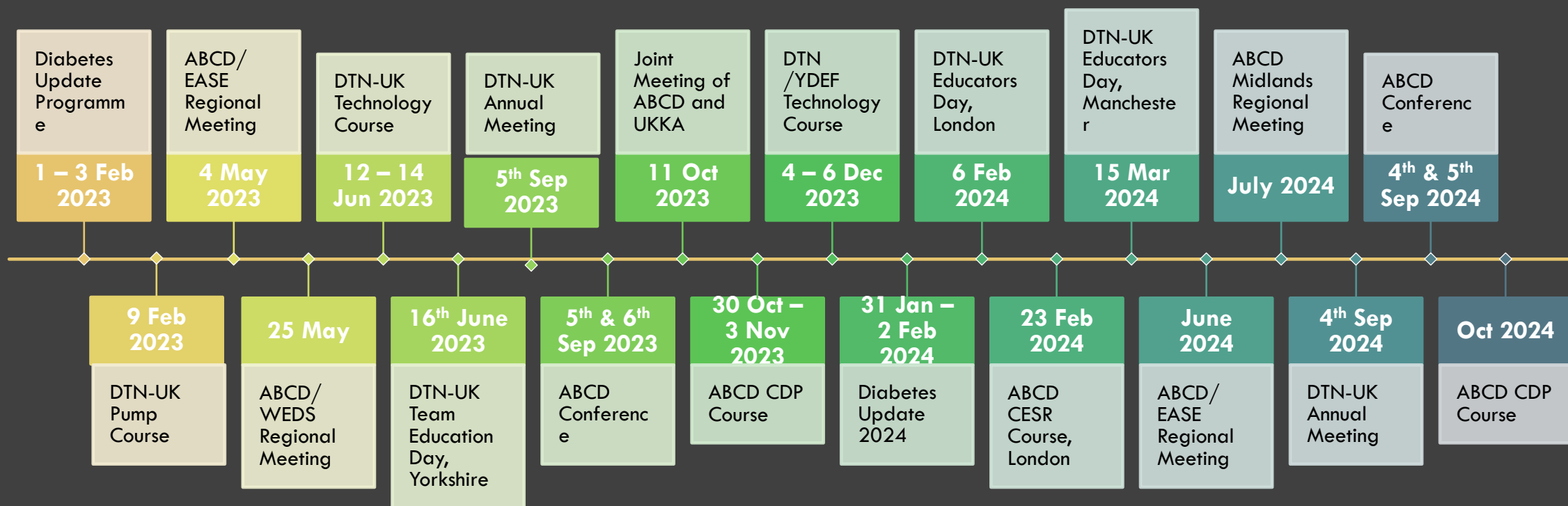

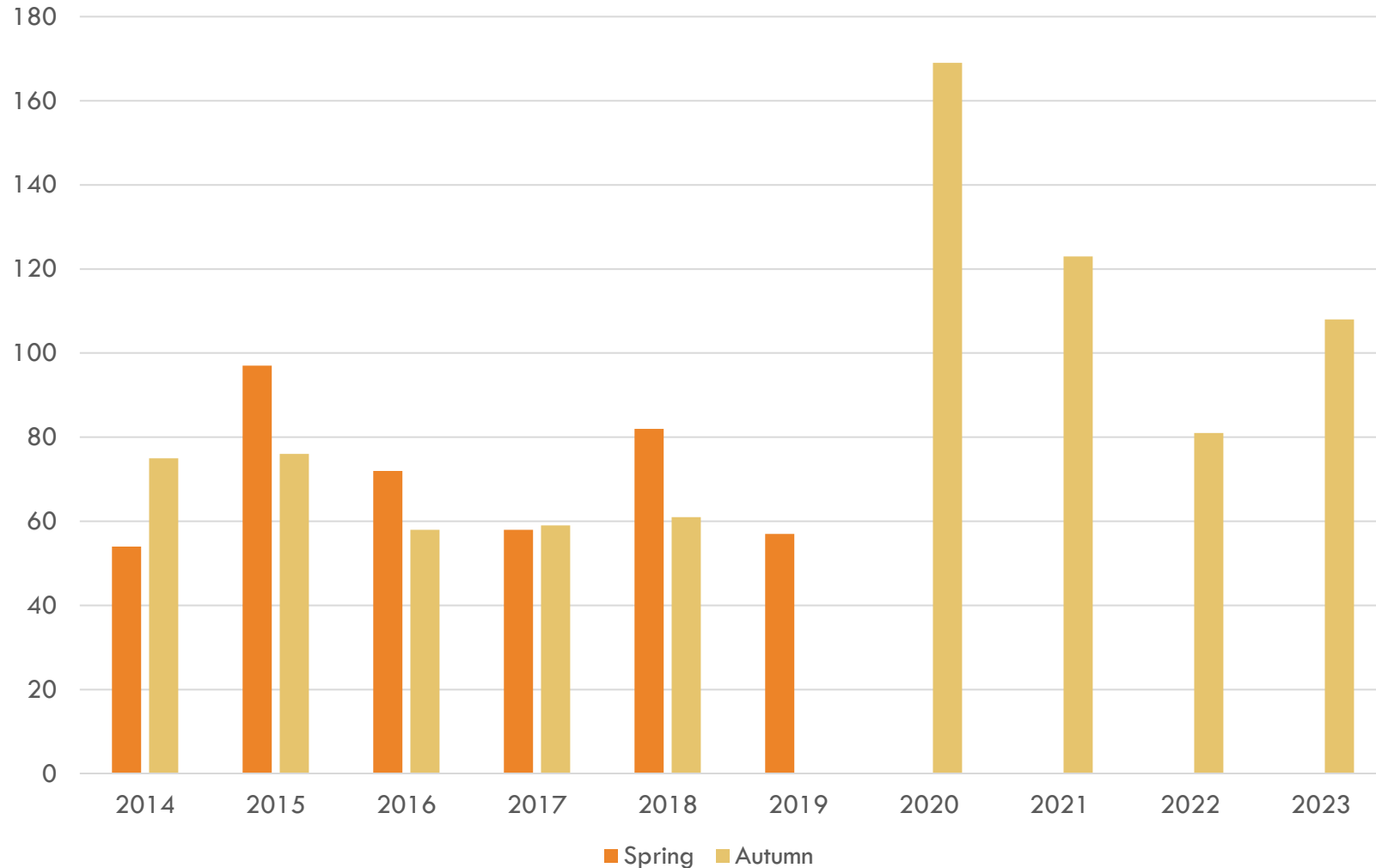

PLAN FOR 2024

- New web application form developed with help from RHI is now live and has helped pipeline & planning
 - Named lead for event
 - As part of this application –requirement to confirm ED&I policy – ie embedded in the meeting preparation
- Review of CPD approvals process has identified the opportunity for an organisational account with the RCP – in progress.
 - Shared internal access will better identify how CPD approvals are progressing
