

## BJD Report for committee meeting on 11th March 2024

There were 41 new submissions in 2023 compared to 37 submissions in 2022, 54 submissions in 2021 and 59 submissions in 2020. 2024 has started encouragingly with 14 new submissions to date.

The BJD June issue will be a bumper issue and will be showcasing six papers from the Re:Mission study (the qualitative study of the low-calorie diet pilots for remission of type 2 diabetes) from Louisa Ells's group. Chris Walton has been leading on this. The six papers will be printed as a mini-edition for Diabetes UK in April 2024.

After some chasing we finally received confirmation last November that our application to COPE (Committee on Publication Ethics) has been accepted. We can now start preparing our application for PubMed Central.

Average time in review (from submission to decision returned to authors, including papers submitted within previous 12 months and resubmissions) = **31.48 days** (25 days in December, 27 days in October/ November, 30 days in September, 32.3 days in August, 33.45 days in May, 32.5 days in March).

We continue to rely on the goodwill of a few reviewers for the quick turnaround of manuscripts. Chris Walton (deputy editor), Jen Atkinson (RHI), and I continue with our weekly Zoom meetings, and we have an editorial board meeting every 2 months, again via Zoom.
