



2023 Declaration of Interest Summary Report

All trustees and most ABCD and subcommittee members have now declared their conflict of interests for 2023 and a report of these submissions has been compiled.

The results show a good balance of representation across pharmaceutical companies, with most trustees and committee members declaring less than 2% of their income from these sources and one trustee declaring between 2% and 10% of their gross annual income from several pharmaceutical companies. No one company received significantly more representation than others.

Six committee members declared between 2% and 10% of income across several pharmaceutical and device companies. One committee member declared over 20% income for private health care and one committee member and one trustee declared over 20% income from other healthcare charity/not-for-profit organisation. Six committee members declared over 20% of their income from other areas.
