



The ABCD Worldwide Omnipod Audit - Objectives

Using modern technologies to facilitate easy gathering of anonymised data, ABCD has set up a worldwide audit of the Omnipod® DASH Insulin Management System in real clinical use worldwide. The aim will be to ascertain whether the experience in real clinical use matches the data from clinical trials. Clinicians using Omnipod will be invited to submit the data that they routinely collect as they monitor the progress of their patients to the audit. An IT tool has been developed to make this process as easy and user friendly as possible. It will also facilitate easy analysis of locally collected data by the local clinicians. ABCD hopes to gain insight into efficacy of Omnipod. ABCD hopes that the data from the audit will inform future practice and guidelines.

From the data submitted in the audit ABCD hopes it might be able to quantify and analyse in detail:

- 1. **EFFICACY**: Explore the impact on Hba1c and time in range.
- 2. **SAFETY**: Describe the impact on severe hypoglycaemia and hospital admissions.
- 3. UTILITY AND ACCEPTANCE: Determine acceptability of the devices.
- 4. **PSYCHOSOCIAL**: Evaluate impact on diabetes related distress.
